

Sub: Grant of Conditional Permission to the Government Siddha Medical College, Aringnar, Anna Hospital Campus, Arumbakkam, Chennai-600106, Tamil Nadu with 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course and 34 seats in 05 PG courses viz. (i) Maruthuvam- 10 seats, (ii) Gunapadam- 10 seats, (iii) Sirappu Maruthuvam – 05 seats, (iv) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam -05 seats and (v) Noi Naadal and Noi Mudhal Naadal- 04 seats for the academic session 2019-20 under section 13A/13C of the IMCC Act, 1970- reg.

Sir/Madam,

- I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order no. R.17013/02/2016-EP (IM-1) dated 24.10.2016 related to admission matter for a period not exceeding 5 years from the academic session 2016-17 to 2020-21 intimating that the college shall maintain all the Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as per extant regulations *in toto* during the permission period (2016-17 to 2020-21).
2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 13-14.03.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, certain deficiencies have been observed and therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 17.05.2019 to present the case.
3. The observations of hearing committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", PG Siddha Regulation, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made there under and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) and it is found that the college is not fulfilling all the norms of notified Regulations for granting permission for a period of five years (100% criteria). However, the said college is fulfilling all the norms for granting conditional permission (permission for a period of one year) for UG (BSMS) course and PG courses for the academic year 2019-20.

4. Therefore, it has been decided by the Central Government to withdraw permission granted for a period not exceeding 5 years from the academic session 2016-17 to 2020-21 vide orders dated 24.10.2016 and to grant Conditional Permission to Government Siddha Medical College, Aringnar, Anna Hospital Campus, Arumbakkam, Chennai-600106, Tamil Nadu for conducting 60 seats in UG (BSMS) course and 34 seats in 05 PG courses viz. (i) Maruthuvam-10 seats, (ii) Gunapadam- 10 seats, (iii) Sirappu Maruthuvam – 05 seats, (iv) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam -05 seats and (v) Noi Naadal and Noi Mudhal Naadal- 04 seats for the academic session 2019-20 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.
5. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate seats and postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG seats and 34 PG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to co-operate with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.
8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:
- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Siddha);
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*; and
 - (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter No. P-14014/09/2019-EP (1) dated 25.05.2019 related to admission matter for the academic year 2019-20 intimating certain requirements to be fulfilled by the college for consideration of permission for the academic session 2020-21.

2. Further, refer to the CCIM's letter No.18-12/2020. Siddha (C-02) dated 23.10.2020 forwarding therewith recommendation of the college to the Central Government based on thorough examination of the visitation report Part-I, indemnity bond, affidavit & latest details of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff submitted by the college along with the assessment report, as the physical verification by conduction of inspection could not be carried out in view of present COVID-19 pandemic situation for the A.Y. 2020-21. On examining the same in terms of Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016”, Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BSMS) course and 05 PG Courses.

3. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to Government Siddha Medical College, Aringnar, Anna Hospital Campus, Arumbakkam, Chennai-600106, Tamil Nadu for conducting with 75 seats (including EWS seats) in UG (BSMS) course and 43 seats (including EWS seats) in 05 PG courses namely (i) Noi Naadal - 06 seats (including EWS), (ii) Maruthuvam - 11 seats(including EWS) , (iii) Gunapadam - 12 seats(including EWS) , (iv) Sirappu Maruthuvam - 07 seats(including EWS) , and (v) Kuzhanthai Maruthuvam - 07 seats (including EWS) for the academic session 2020-21 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.
7. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2020 to get permission for the session 2020-21:
 - (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Siddha Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Siddha);
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*; and
 - (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Siddha Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
8. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. 
